Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing our learning about place value within 100. We have previously encountered numberlines to 10, 20 and 50. We will use our knowledge of counting to and from 100 in 1s and 10s, to label numberlines with different starting and ending points. We will then explore finding one more and one less of a given number within 100. We will be thinking about how we find one more and one less of a number when it is a multiple of ten. Following this, we will be comparing numbers using the language 'greater than' 'less than' and 'equal to'.

Maths Homework

Can you draw your own numberline using numbers within 100? What will you start and end number be? Will it count in 1s or 10s?

English

In English we continue with descriptive writing. We will be changing the setting, thinking of the different places the magic bubbles might take us. The children will use adjectives to describe where they go and use thesaurus' to uplevel common words. We will also continue working on capital letters and full stops. The children will also be reflecting on their individual targets.

Phonics and Reading

We will be revisiting graphemes that our children have found particularly tricky over the last few weeks. For example: aw (or) ew (u-e and oo) au (or) and split digraphs. We will be spotting the digraphs in words and sounding and blending a range of real and alien words.

Across the week we will also be revising all of the tricky words we have learned this year.

**Our fluency text this week is a speech for children about sustainability entitled:
*Let's Be Superheroes For Our Planet!***

Topic



This week will have a science focus as we take part in the BET Academy Green Week.

On Monday we will be discussing favourite meals and looking at meat free recipes.

On Tuesday the school councillors will be meeting with the School Business manager and premises assistant to discuss how Green we are as a school and what which area we need to improve on the most.

On Wildlife Wednesday we will be outside planting and investigating: How pollinator friendly is your area? We will be learning about pollinators and ground dwellers.

On Thrifty Thursday we will be discussing the 3 R's: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle and developing designs for a machine to clean up plastics from the ocean.
