## Maths

In Maths this week we will be consolidating previous learning on place value between 50 and 100. We will be making different numbers, ordering numbers, using part whole models and writing number sentences.

### Maths Homework

You will need 2 players/teams. Make one set of 0-9 digit cards and turn them face down so you can't see the numeral. Both team needs a Tens and Ones base card. Each team takes a card and chooses where to place the digit card- to help make their own 2 digit number or put it into their opponent's base card. The winner is the team that makes the highest number.
