RE: Children will learn about how giving and receiving makes us happy.

PSHE: Children will begin the module 'Growing and changing'.

Music: Children will begin the module 'Musical me'.

D&T: Children will begin the module 'Food: a balanced diet'.

Art: Children will begin the module 'Craft and design: Map it out'.

Computing: Children will begin the module on 'Coding'.

PE: For this half term, we will be looking at 'Invasion' and 'Athletics'.
