Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Tell Us a Story!

We are going to looking at stories and what is in them. Our focus will be on traditional tales and in particular, Jack and the Beanstalk.

Theme for the Week:

This week the children will become Storytime Stars, making their own books on a topic of their choice and reading their stories to the class. In addition, we will be reading the Easter Story, discussing why Easter is important to Christian's and exploring how they celebrate it. The pupils will be designing and making their own Easter cards to give to someone who is special to them.

In PHSE we will be continuing our learning about money and what we use it for and how to use it well.

Phonics:

This week in Phonics, we will be reviewing the Phase 3 sounds: 'ai' 'ee' 'igh' 'oa' 'oo' 'oo' 'ur' 'er' 'ow'. We will be practising blending the sounds together to read and reviewing the tricky words we have learnt so far.

Maths:

In maths this week, we will be exploring the composition of numbers up to 10 using 3 parts (e.g. 3+2+5=10). Children will begin to understand that there can be 2 or more parts that make a whole. In addition, we will be learning what it means to double a number and exploring doubles up to 10.
