Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will continue their learning about 'Addition and Subtraction'. Children will be recapping and learning:

- Add two 2-digit numbers (across 10)
- Subtract two-digit numbers (not across a 10)

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, children will write the ending of their fairytales, and they will be evaluating their fairytales to check they have included the key features and focus grammar objectives.

Reading:

Children will be focusing on a VIPER from a seen and un-seen text.

Fluency:

This week, we will continue to look at a poem called 'Ugly sisters'.

Learning in school:

Children will be working through the bridge to spelling unit and reviewing Phase 5 graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing sentences and spelling using these graphemes.

Topic

Learning in school:

History/Geograpy: Children will continue to look at Antarctica and look at explorers who go to the North Pole. The children will also look at the explorer Amundsen.

PSHE: Children will continue to look at 'people who are special to us'.

Art: Children will continue with their art module for this half term, which is called 'Painting and mixed media: Life in colour.

Music: We will continue with their music module for this half term, which is called "Orchestral instruments. Theme: Traditional Western stories'. Children will also start to practise singing the Christmas production songs.

Computing: We will continue with the module called 'creating pictures' module in Purple Mash

PE: For this half term, we will be looking at Dance.
