Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Dangerous Dinosaurs!

We are going back in time to widen our knowledge about dinosaurs. We will be looking at the similarities and differences between the dinosaurs, their size and features. We will also be learning facts using non-fiction books and learning how to look after dinosaurs.

Theme for the Week:

This week we will be exploring dinosaur information books, researching exciting facts and creating our own dinosaur fact books. As part of our materials topic in science, we will be investigating some properties of materials and making our own dinosaur fossils out of salt dough.

Phonics:

This week, we will be recapping the phase 3 sounds and tricky words we have been practising this half term.

Maths:

In maths this week, we will be exploring number 6, 7 and 8 and how we can represent these numbers in different ways.

The aim of the homework is to help the children learn to subitise (recognise without counting) dotty amounts and to begin to learn some simple addition facts off by heart. If you do
