Maths

In maths next week we will be continuing our learning about number lines to 20. The children will use this knowledge to estimate where numbers within 20 are placed on a number line.

We will revisit the terms, greater than, less than and equal to, to compare and order numbers within 20. We will then apply this understanding to use inequality symbols ($>$ $<$ $=$) to compare two numbers within 20.

English

Thank you for all the fabulous facts you researched, the children have been keen to share their facts! This week we will be using our knowledge of non-fiction text features to help us create our own fact pages about our chosen animal. We will be focussing on writing our own questions and punctuating these sentences with a question mark. Next week the children will then answer their question by writing facts about their animal.

Phonics

In phonics next week we will be learning...

New GPC's: *le, al, ce (s) ve*

Tricky words: *school, call, different*

Reading

We will be looking at animal non fiction texts with a focus on retrieval.

Our fluency text is called: *Animal Antics (AI generated)*

Topic

Science: In Science we will be continuing our animal grouping knowledge with a focus this week on fish and amphibians.

RE: This week the children will explore further the importance of the Torah within the Jewish community. We will be thinking about The Ten Commandments and how this demonstrates what is important to God. The children will relate this learning to their own experiences of rules within our school community.

DT: We will be starting our new unit 'Puppets'. This week, children will evaluate existing puppets and design a hand puppet from a fairy tale.

Computing: In computing we will be starting a new unit called Lego builders. The children will begin to explore the term 'algorithms' by following an accurate set of instructions to get the correct result when building.

PE: We will be continuing with our dance unit on weather, where we are moving to the count of 8.
