Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Fabulous Festivals!

During this topic we will learning about how people and communities celebrate in different ways and why this is important to them.

Theme for the week: This week Christmas is coming to our classrooms! The children will be helping to put the tree up and decorating the classroom. We are also making our hats for the Christmas performance and getting ready for our dress rehearsal to the rest of the school.

Phonics

In phonics this week, we will be continuing our learning of words with s / s / added at the end (hats sits) and words ending s / z / (his) and with s / z / added at the end (bags). Our tricky words will be **we**, **me**, **be**.

Maths:

This week in maths, identify and name shapes with 4 sides, combine shapes with 4 sides to make another shape, looking for shapes in the environment in particular square and rectangles and then looking at day and night and the sequence of our day.
