### Maths

#### Learning in school:

In maths, children will be learning about Place value. Children will be learning to:

- > Partition numbers to 100
- > Write numbers to 100 in words
- > Flexibly partition numbers to 100
- > Write numbers to 100 in expanded form

English, Reading & Fluency

### Learning in school:

In English, children will be learning about sentence structure and writing sentences about space, using colourful semantics - who, what doing, what and where.

#### Reading:

This week will be individual reads. Please make sure that your child's book is in their book bag.

## Fluency:

This week, we will be looking at a poem called 'Queue for the zoo' by Clare Bevan

Please continue to read at home and upload your comments onto the 'BoomReader' app.

SPAG Learning in school: Children will be reviewing Phase 5 graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing sentences and spelling using these graphemes. Topic Learning in school: Geography: Children will be learning where Stoneleigh is located in context to the UK, Europe, Earth and the Solar System.

PSHE: Children will focus on 'what would Roo Do' in different scenarios.

RE: Children will be learning about 'What do some Christians say about God?'

Computing: We will begin our 'making music' module in Purple Mash.

D&T: Children will begin their D&T module for this half term, which is called Mechanisms: Making a moving alien

PE: For this half term, we will be looking at Team Building and Fitness.

Reading is an integral part of our curriculum and is celebrated and encouraged throughout each school day. In year two, each child will read their reading book every first (full) and last week of the half term with an adult at school. This helps us ensure that every child is working at an appropriate level and is set an appropriately phased text.

We ask that you also support individual reading at home, four times a week. All reading records should be logged onto 'Boom Reader,' (formerly Go Read.) When your child has read their book and is confident please encourage them to change it. We will also give the children reminders to support this.
