## ...January 2025...

### <u>Maths</u>

In the new year we will be thinking about teen numbers and place value. We will be using our knowledge of tens and ones and using manipulatives to help us understand digits within each teen number.

#### **English**

In the New Year we will be starting our new topic, 'All Creatures Great and Small.' We will start by creating labels and captions for some mystery creatures! Within this topic we will be looking a lot at non - fiction texts and creating our own.

#### Phonics and reading

We will be carrying out 1:1 reading and our first fluency text for 2024 will be a rhyme entitled: New Year's Here! We will be focusing on pauses.

#### **Topic**

Science - In science next term we will be thinking about the different animal groups: fish, reptiles, amphibians and mammals. Over the term we will be learning to classify them using specific terminology.

In DT we will be making puppets this term. In RE we will be learning about special books in different Religions.
